

## **PBA Seeks Candidates for Pennsylvania Delegation to the ABA House of Delegates**

The PBA is seeking candidates to fill three open seats on the Pennsylvania delegation to the ABA House of Delegates.

The delegation, currently at 16 members, is broken down into several categories: PBA-appointed delegates, county-appointed delegates, state-elected delegate, and ABA-appointed delegates. The PBA is allotted eight seats, each of which carries a two-year term. The PBA Board of Governors chooses the nominees, who are then officially voted into office by the PBA House of Delegates. Terms for these seats will run from August 2017 (at the close of the ABA Annual Meeting) through August 2019 (at the close of the ABA Annual Meeting).

Candidates must be able to attend the following ABA meetings:

- ABA Midyear Meeting – Jan. 31-Feb. 6, 2018, Vancouver, British Columbia
- ABA Annual Meeting – Aug. 2-7, 2018, Chicago
- ABA Midyear Meeting – Jan. 23-29, 2019, Las Vegas
- ABA Annual Meeting – Aug. 8-13, 2019, San Francisco

Meeting expenses are not covered except for transportation to and from the ABA Midyear Meeting. These transportation expenses must be submitted to the ABA for reimbursement.

Those who wish to serve as a delegate should send a letter of interest and a resume to Sandra Graver, PBA, P.O. Box 186, 100 South Street, Harrisburg, Pa. 17108-0186. All material must be received no later than March 31, 2017. The PBA House of Delegates will vote on the candidates at its May 12, 2017, meeting.
