LACKAWANNA PRO BONO, INC. ENDOWMENT FACT SHEET

Why has Lackawanna Pro Bono embarked on an endowment campaign? Lackawanna Pro Bono is seeking stable, ongoing funding for the organization to assure that it will be able to provide its crucial services in perpetuity. To accomplish this, it has embarked on a campaign to raise an endowment fund of \$1 million dollars. The income generated by the fund will be used to accomplish the organization's mission.

What endowment funds have been established for Lackawanna Pro Bono? Since 2001, generous donors have established nine endowment funds at the Scranton Area Foundation for the benefit of Lackawanna Pro Bono. These permanent funds offer income to Lackawanna Pro Bono, for use toward operating expenses, while the principal remains with the Scranton Area Foundation. With matching grants from the Scranton Area Foundation, the combined value of the funds as of June 30, 2009 totaled close to \$160,000. The nine funds are listed below.
