Yes. In 2012 Noble Corbin-Bey sued me, the Sheriff's Office and other defendants in federal court. I do not know anything about this case as I was never served with a complaint. Also I found out later that this matter had been dismissed against all parties.

In 2009 Kirt Clayton sued me, other family court judges in Philadelphia in federal court. I never got the complaint and I found out that this matter was dismissed against me and all other judges.

My former law firm was sued by the City of Philadelphia in 2005 for business privilege taxes. I was represented by counsel and the matter was successfully resolved by way of settlement in 2006.

In 2001 I was sued by TERI for a private student loan. It was dismissed with prejudice that same year.

In 1999 City of Philadelphia sued me for taxes. I was given wrong advice by my then accountant. I successfully resolved this matter by way of settlement. I retained a new accountant and my practice was then converted to a professional corporation.


