It has been my privilege to serve the Commonwealth as a Justice on the Pennsylvania Supreme Court. In addition to authoring opinions and otherwise performing my judicial duties, I have been active in the administrative matters of the court. In particular, I chaired the Court's Elder Law Task Force, which published a Report and 130 Recommendations for improving access to justice for our Commonwealth's elders, and which established the Office of Elder Justice in the Courts and the Elder Justice Advisory Council, to which I serve as Liaison Justice. I also serve as Liaison Justice to Pennsylvania's Veterans' Courts, and to the Interbranch Commission for Gender, Racial, and Ethnic Fairness.

I am seeking retention so that I may continue to pursue my commitment to public service as a Justice on our commonwealth's highest court. I also look forward to the opportunity to serve as the first female Chief Justice of Pennsylvania.
