
A PCHR Playbook: The Xs and Os of Practice Before the Philadelphia Commission on Human Relations



Pamela Gwaltney is deputy director of compliance with the Philadelphia Commission on Human Relations (PCHR), the nation's oldest municipal civil rights agency. She manages the enforcement and administration of the Fair Practices Ordinance, which protects the rights of 19 categories of individuals, prohibiting discrimination in housing/real property, employment, public accommodations and the delivery of city services. PCHR also enforces Philadelphia's Fair Chance Hiring law (Ban the Box) and is home to the City of Philadelphia's Fair Housing Commission. In August 2016, Pamela was tapped to testify before the Pennsylvania Senate Committee on Labor & Industry in support of Senate Bill 1306, adding protections in employment for the LGBTQ community based on sexual orientation and gender identity or expression to the Pennsylvania Human Relations Act. Previously, Pamela worked in the Pennsylvania Human Relations Commission (PHRC) as assistant chief counsel and as an education attorney in the executive office. Pamela was also a trial attorney for the Defender Association of Philadelphia. She is a graduate of Hampton University and Temple University's Beasley School of Law
