The recipient of this Award will be a lawyer in public or private practice that has made an outstanding contribution in the area of administrative law in Pennsylvania.

Nominees must satisfy the following criteria:

1. Practice or conduct professional activity primarily in Pennsylvania.
2. Hold a license to practice in Pennsylvania, in good standing and active status, but may be an educator or a non-practicing attorney.
3. Have had a significant impact in the practice of administrative law.
4. Demonstrate leadership in mentoring other attorneys in administrative law.
