The Pennsylvania Bar Association Commission on Women in the Profession is pleased to present a special Spring Conference program focusing on the film "Madame Presidenta: Why Not U.S.?" which has been produced by the Women and Girls Foundation of Pittsburgh. "Madame Presidenta: Why Not U.S.?" chronicles the journey of two women, one from the U.S. and one from Rio de Janeiro, as they explore the key question of why so many other countries have elected female presidents before the United States. In the process they make important discoveries about new democracies, community, and women's rights.

Dilma Rousseff, former Marxist guerrilla, Minister of Energy, and Chief of Staff, is leading Brazil during a time of unprecedented economic growth and transition. Brazil, a country that is both energy independent and rich in natural resources has recently overtaken the UK to become the world's sixth-biggest economy. It is a country on the rise, led by women.

Join Heather Arnet, the film's creator and the CEO of the Women and Girls Foundation, and other women to watch this fascinating film and then explore how we, as American women, can emulate Presidenta Rousseff's success in our own law firms, our local communities, and even at the state and national levels. We will discuss such issues as what it takes to effect change in our professional lives; how the film applies to us in the legal profession; what did Dilma Rousseff do right either before or after becoming president and how can we learn from that or apply it to our professional lives; how qualities such as grit, mentoring, and leaning in come into play in the film. This is a call to arms for women everywhere to become more involved in the political process — both inside the law firm and outside — to continue firmly establishing women as leaders.
